

- Authoritative Church teachings on social, political and economic issues.
- It is a collection of writings by popes, bishops and Church Fathers (saints and teachers of the early Church).
- CST reflects on social issues of the day in the light of scripture.
- It is our moral compass, giving guidelines for action. It shows how Catholic faith can guide our responses to modern day issues.



Subsidiarity Sid the sheep's story



Sid enjoys hanging out with his flock in his favourite field. Sometimes their owner, Farmer Dale asks them to move to a new field where the grass is a bit greener but they have come to realise that one field has nicer tasting grass.

One day Farmer Dale tells them they'd be moving fields again, but Sid and his cousins explained that they'd prefer to stay for a few more days until the grass had been eaten. At first Farmer Dale wasn't happy, but then he realised that the sheep were in a better position to make the decision and it actually affected them most. Now Farmer Dale spends more time listening to the sheep.

Sid's story helps us to remember that everyone has important ideas and knows what is best for their families and communities. They need to have a say in decisions which affect them.

Putting people most in need first

Preferential option for the poor Poppy the popokotea's story

When Poppy hatched, she was all alone and never <u>knew</u> her parents. She remembers having to rely on kind birds caring for he and bringing her worms to eat.

As one of the youngest and most vulnerable, she understands what it was like to have nothing and the need to rely on others.

She is much older now and has started a "Worms-4-U" service for birds in need everywhere.

Poppy's story tells us that we should think first about the needs of people who need help the most.

Mary says "I am from Syria. I was five when I came here. I miss things, like my grandmother who passed away. We used to play together."

She lived in a small house in Syria that was very beautiful.

"We had a garden and I used to play hide and seek there with my brothers and sisters. I like to play."

When she grows up, she would like to be a doctor.

Mary and Waleed are taking part in a project where they use films and puppets to talk about their experiences and start to rebuild their lives.
